

If the police stop you you at a protest:

Ask if you're being detained or arrested.

If they say **no**, you can:

- walk away
- not answer questions
- not let them search you or your property
- not show them your ID

You can record the police if you do not get in their way.

If the police say you're detained or arrested:

- Ask **Why?**
- Say **I want to speak to a lawyer.** The police must help you call a free lawyer.
- Stay silent.
- Ask for an interpreter if you need one.

Do **not** resist or struggle if you're detained or arrested.
