

If you're protesting peacefully...

The police cannot:

- search you
- detain you
- make you show ID

But if the police think you've committed a crime, they can detain and search you.

You can:

- refuse to answer questions
- record the police but you can't get in their way while recording

If you think you're detained or arrested:

- Don't resist or struggle.
- Ask **Am I free to go?**
- Say **I want to speak to a lawyer.** The police must help you call a free lawyer.
- Don't answer questions, but give your name and date of birth.
